### Recent completion of 50+ bridge surveys

We have recently completed a run of 51 railway bridge surveys located between the Midlands and the far South West. The surveys, described as Hydrostatic Surveys were to enable bridge deck stabilisation works. Deliverables included upstream elevation/cross section, long section through the structure a sufficient distance downstream to analyse channel gradient and simple plan layout of abutments, columns/piers and deck (including steel sizes).
